Family School Aid Fund

The *Family School Aid Fund* is used for members of St. Peter Lutheran Church and community families who need financial assistance in sending their child(ren) to our school to receive a Christian education. The fund is replenished through donations, memorials, St. Peter Lutheran Church and School Endowment, and 5% of the annual school tuition.

In order to be fair and impartial, St. Peter uses *FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment (FACTS)* for our outside evaluation service. Parents are required to pay a fee (currently \$40.00) for the family application. Once FACTS has reviewed the application, it is sent back to the principal and then reviewed anonymously by a committee who reviews the suggestions of FACTS. The principal will then contact the family on their grant amount. The committee may waive portions of an unpaid account in cases of a temporary or long-term crisis which was not noticed until after the original applications were reviewed.

The grant money will help to pay only for tuition or book fees for children attending Preschool-8th grade of our school. It will not cover sports fees, band fees, field trips or class trips, lunch costs, and other costs for special school activities.
